

Garry's sixth solo release began during a long Covid-19 lockdown, and the need to escape to the comfort of music that might help us travel in our imaginations. It's a wide-ranging instrumental and conceptually cinematic album released in both stereo and immersive 5.1 Surround Sound.

Musical influences range from pop, rock, jazz noir, reggae, gamelan, Indian drone and African, to retroelectronic and orchestral ambient.
